I realize my child is an important part of LC United and their team. As such: I am aware of my financial commitment to LC United. I have been given several different options to pay my dues and understand my balance is to be paid in full. The set of uniforms in the kit for my child is included within the dues. If I have made other arrangements with my coach or team manager, I will follow up to ensure there's no miscommunication regarding my dues balance and attach documentation. We will arrive at each team practice or game in time to participate at the beginning of practice or game in the required and complete practice or game kit. Ensure the appropriate playing equipment is brought to all events (shin guards, cleats, head and dental protection, ball, etc.) Make sure they hydrate properly and eat healthy that will allow them to do their very best throughout a practice or game. They will also bring enough water for the whole game, practice, or event... While at a practice or game, I will instruct my child to treat the coach, teammates, parents (including their own) and officials with dignity and respect. Be professional at all events and keep any criticism to myself regarding all children (including my own) both on and off the field. Mistakes on the field are an integral part of the learning process and only make my teammates and team better. I understand the 24-hour requirement of withholding critical comments of play regarding my player, team or coach after any event. _I will not speak to any game official, referee, opposing player, parent or coach unless I am going to compliment them. _If I am unhappy for any reason, I will tell my coach or team manager as soon as possible. _Acknowledge that what I post on Social Media (Snap Chat, Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, etc.) exists forever and may do harm to my child, their team and myself. If I decide to post something negative or controversial, I may be asked to delete or possibly leave the team. Should I decide to post on any public forum, I will not mention LC United in my post. If I do, I understand that I will be asked to delete the post. Expect my child to possibly compete in up to 3 tournaments each year and will plan accordingly so they can participate and help their team. I thoroughly understand that this is a developmental team and competitive team, and have been given no assurance of game playing time nor expect any for my child, other than what has been earned in the opinion of the LC United coaches, not mine.
